

WILLOWAY POOL RULES

1. **Gate MUST be locked at all times.** Residents (Co-owners/Tenants) must have the WCA pool fob with them at all times when in the pool enclosure. **No one should be admitted to the pool enclosure without a pool fob. You are directly responsible for anyone you allow into the pool enclosure using the "Exit button" or using your Unit's pool fob.**
2. **Unit Resident MUST be present** at the pool with their guests. Residents are responsible for the actions of their guests at all times. Unattended guests will be asked to leave the pool enclosure. Violations of the Pool Rules may result in deactivation of the pool fob and any associated fees.
3. **NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.** All persons using the pool and pool area do so at their own risk and agree to abide by the rules for the use of the pool. WCA and AMI Management assume no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use or for any loss or damage to personal property. Non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult swimmer of capable abilities at all times. Anyone **under 16 years of age** should be accompanied by an adult.
4. Persons having an infectious or communicable disease or possible infectious condition, such as a cold, skin eruption or open blister are not permitted in the pool. Band-aids and other bandages are not allowed in the pool.
5. **NO DIVING.** No spitting, spouting water from the mouth, or blowing the nose in the pool. No running, pushing, wrestling, or other rough play or unsafe conduct is permitted in the pool or the pool enclosure.
6. Use of the pool after the consumption of alcohol or drugs is prohibited. No smoking, chewing gum or profane language.
7. **NO FOOD or ALCOHOL is allowed in the pool enclosure.** Food is allowed in the gazebo area. Non-alcoholic beverages are permitted in plastic containers with closed tops. NO GLASS or similar material with a tendency to shatter on impact is allowed in the pool enclosure.
8. No animals, except certified service animals, are allowed in the pool enclosure. Service animals may not enter the pool.
9. Swimmers must wear clean and proper bathing attire. No street clothes/shoes, cutoffs or jeans in the pool. Any person who is incontinent or not fully potty-trained must wear appropriate waterproof clothing, such as swim diapers or elasticized pants, when entering or being carried into the pool.
10. No wheeled vehicles (skateboards, bicycles, scooters, etc.) are permitted in the pool enclosure at any time, with the exception of vehicles for the physically challenged and infant strollers.

EMERGENCY PHONE is for emergency use only. It is connected directly to Bloomfield Township Emergency Services.

Pool rules are for the safety and enjoyment to all in the WCA community. Co-owners, Tenants, their family members and guests who violate the rules will be asked to leave the pool and pool area. Repeat violations will result in deactivation of the pool fob and subsequent deactivation and re-activation fees. The Association is required to adhere to Health and Safety Rules and Regulations set forth by the State of Michigan and Oakland County.
